Many may now be aware, that planning permission has been submitted for the building of 24 dwellings on this land. The site belongs to the Diocese of Salford, not the Parish. Any revenue generated returns directly to the Diocese. As a result of this sale, initial building work will commence to establish a retaining wall. This will identify new legal boundaries of existing properties. Please be aware that this work will result in a smaller parking space being available at the site of St Peter's church.
